

Carolina Region Beach Volleyball Referee Certification Guidelines and Information



USAV Beach Volleyball Official certification levels:

1. Local: (4-year term)

A. Allows you to officiate and be a court monitor at any CR event. Also, you may be invited to work at a NAIA, NJCAA or NCAA- D3 college beach tournament (this would be by invite only from a college assignor).

B. The certification process is to submit form linked below and attend a training/certification site.

2. Zonal: (4-year term)

A. Allows you to officiate and be a court monitor at any CR event. Also, you may be invited to work at a NAIA, NJCAA or NCAA- D1, 2 and 3 college beach tournament (this would be by invite only from a college assignor).

B. Contact your Beach Officials chair of your intent. And then attend a USAV Zonal certification course.

3. National: (4-year term)

A. Allows you to officiate and be a court monitor at any CR event. Also, you may be invited to work at a NAIA, NJCAA or NCAA- D1, 2 and 3 college beach tournament (this would be by invite only from a college assignor).

B. Contact your Beach Officials chair of your intent. And then attend a USAV National certification course.

Beach volleyball is an emerging sport at the college level. This means that you may have to travel some to get matches. You are also required to work outdoors in all kinds of weather- hot, cold, sunshine and rain! Beach volleyball has many similarities to indoor and many differences!
